

Some Panama Birds Video

In 2005 we retired and moved to the Highlands of Western Panama. We were motivated primarily by the needs for adventure, change and natural beauty.

A significant part of this adventure has been hunting and observing the rich birdlife of Panama with over 1000 species of endemic and migrant birds.

I began the hobby of photographing birds in 2009 with the digiscope method using a small digital camera and a spotting scope.

These photos were taken over the span of 11 years in various parts of Panama but mostly in the Province of Chiriqui in the District of Boquete where we live.

This video presents 263 of Panama's many bird species. They are presented below by common name in alphabetical order along with their scientific names and links to more information. Each of these photos come with a story. They are the result of adventures.

The adventure story includes the hunt. While some birds may come to you most have to be sought and carefully approached, requiring effort, vigilance, readiness, and gobs of patience.

The adventure includes selecting equipment and mastering the essentials of camera, lenses and mounts to handle the unique challenges. It requires lugging everything needed combined with a readiness for the exact moment of framing and capturing the image. It includes mastery of the software that selects, edits and processes the images. It includes studying the birds and equipment through books, teachers, friends and experience.

Focused attention and lots of time are required.

It is challenging and isn't easy but it is rewarding being in nature observing and capturing images of these special inhabitants of our earth home.

Some of the birds in this video are commonly found in Panama but others are very difficult to locate and are rarely seen. If you want to know more about the birds in this list and where to find them check out the following resources:
